**Martin Miller Westbourne Strength, England/Iceland**  
Martin Miller's gin is technically English - distilled in pot stills in England but unusually then shipped to Iceland, where it is mixed with Icelandic spring water.



**Kongsgaard Gin, Denmark**  
Danish small-batch gin with apples at its core with other botanicals also inspired by the woods, creating a spirit with complex notes of earth, flower and fruit.



**Herno Old Tom Gin, Sweden**  
Using meadowsweet to impart extra sweetness, this is then heightened with the addition of touches of honey and sugar before bottling.



**Kyro Napue Gin, Finland**  
A rye-based gin, Napue's botanicals include meadowsweet, sea-buckthorn and cranberries. Crisp and refreshing with a spicy pepper note.



**Bivrost Arctic Gin, Norway**  
World's northernmost gin. Made in the Arctic, at the foot of the Lyngen Alps with glacial water and locally harvested botanicals.

*Distilled at the world's northernmost distillery, BIVROST Arctic Gin is a fusion of classic gin spices and Arctic botanicals. Made under the magic of the Northern Lights, and mixed with pure glacial meltwater, this gin is rich in both flavor and heritage. The name BIVROST dates back to old Norse mythology; 'Biv', which means shaking and 'Rost', which means road or path. It is considered to be the word the Vikings used for describing the Northern Lights - the magical bridge between Asgard, the world of gods, and Midgard, the world of men.*
